The post has all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidates shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules. The Last date of receipt of application is 06th November 2009 (06/11/2009) for all states except North-Eastern states, Sikkim, Ladakh division of J&K State, Lahaul & Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba Distt of HP, Andaman & Nicobar Island and Lakshadweep for which last date is 13th November 2009 (13/11/2009).

2. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -**

- a) Pay Scale – Rs. 5200 – 20200 + Grade Pay Rs. 2,000/- per month.
 b) Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. They will be covered under new restructured defined contributory pension system.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) **AGE: – Between 18 to 23 Years (Cut off date for age will be 6th November 2009)**

Note :-

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.
- (b) Ex-Servicemen being trained soldier will be required to qualify the written test, trade test and Medical fitness test. (iv) **MEDICAL STANDARDS:**

- a) **Eye Sight:** The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of both eyes without correction i.e. without wearing glasses.
- b) The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

10. **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit Cards to appear in the recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit Card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:-

- a) **Checking of documents:** The candidates who report at the designated recruitment centres on the given date and time will be required to produce their educational and other documents in original for verification of age, educational and professional qualifications etc. Original documents will be returned on the spot after verification.
- b) **Physical Measurement:** Candidates found eligible in documentation will be screened first for height, chest, and weight measurements.
- c) **PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST:** The PET will be qualifying in nature and will not carry any marks. The candidates who are found fit in Physical Measurements will be required to pass Physical Efficiency Test consisting of following events:-

(i)	1 mile race to be completed in six and half minutes
(ii)	11 feet long jump (3 chances to be given)
(iii)	3½ feet high jump (3 chances to be given)

Note: (i) Those who do not qualify the Physical Efficiency Tests will get eliminated from there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

- (ii) No Physical Efficiency tests will be held for Departmental Candidates and Ex-Servicemen. However, they will be required to pass the written, trade test and medical examination.

d) **Written Examination (25 Marks):**

- i) The candidates qualifying in the physical efficiency test will be required to appear in written test.
 ii) The written test will consist of objective, as well as descriptive type questions.
 iii) Total 33% marks for SC/ST/OBC candidates and 35% for General and Ex-Servicemen are required to qualify the written test.

(e) **Trade Tests (60 Marks):** Trade test for the applied trade will be conducted for those who qualify in Written Test.


- a. Cobbler: - Polishing of shoes, handling tools, cutting of leather, repair and stitching of shoes.
 b. Tailor: - Taking measurement, cutting of cloths and stitching of uniform.
 c. Gardener: - Should have knowledge of:-
 i) Different kinds of plants, flower plants, seasonal plants and to recognize them.
 ii) Knowledge of chemical fertilizers and its use.
 iii) Preservation of seeds of different plants, season of plantation and plantation techniques.
 iv) Budding and grafting of plants.
 v) Preparation of bouquet by combining flowers of different colours.
 vi) Identification of trade tools.

(f) **Interview (15 Marks):** - Interview shall be conducted after trade test.

(g) **Detailed Medical Examination:** Candidates selected in order of merit i.e. equal to the number of notified vacancies, will be put through detailed medical examination to assess their fitness.

11. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come duly prepared for 6-7 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. The Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the Physical Efficiency Test. **No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete application will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application after the last date as mentioned above will be accepted.**
