Applications are invited from male Indian citizens, for filling up of vacancies of above posts in Group-C for the year 2009 on temporary basis likely to be permanent, for the following posts as mentioned against each, in the Indo Tibetan Border Police Force. The post has all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules. The last date of receipt of application is **23<sup>rd</sup> November 2009 for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul-Spiti District and Pangl Sub-Division of Chamba District of HP, Andaman & Nicobar Islands and Lakshadweep for which last date is 30<sup>th</sup> November 2009**

2. **PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES:-**

- a) Head Constable Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs. 2,400/- per month.  
Constable Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs. 2,000/- per month.
- b) Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowances as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. They will be covered under new restructured defined contributory pension scheme.

3. The candidate appearing for the post should mention/intimate if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him in any police station/Hon'ble court.

\* Candidate shall be initially appointed as Constable in the pay scale of Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs 2000/- against the vacancy of Head Constable (Radio Operator). On qualifying the basic training and Radio Operator Grade-III course, they shall be re-appointed as Head Constable (Radio Operator) in the pay scale of Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs 2400/- on the basis of their merit in Radio Operator Grade-III course. Those who could not qualify the Radio Operator Grade-III course, in three attempts, shall be liable to be removed from service or with option to change into General Duty Cadre as Constable subject to availability of vacancies.

OR

Ex-servicemen or Ex-Police personnel who are matriculate or have acquired equivalent qualification and have acquired Radio Operator Grade-III or equivalent proficiency, subject to passing the selection test in the grade organized by the ITB Police Force.

\*\* Candidate shall be initially appointed as Constable in the pay scale of Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs 2000/- against the vacancy of Head Constable (Radio Technician). On qualifying the basic training and Radio Technician Grade-III course, they shall be re-appointed as Head Constable (Radio Technician) in the pay scale of Rs. 5200-20200 + Grade Pay Rs 2400/- on the basis of their merit in Radio Technician Grade-III course. Those who could not qualify the Radio Technician Grade-III course, in three attempts, shall be liable to be removed from service or with option to change into General Duty Cadre as Constable subject to availability of vacancies.

Ex-serviceman or Ex-Police personnel who are Matriculate or have acquired equivalent qualification and have acquired Radio Technician Grade-III or equivalent proficiency, subject to passing the selection test in the grade organized by the ITBPF.

**6. CUT OFF DATE FOR AGE AND RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT:**

**Age:-** Cut off date for determining age will be **23<sup>rd</sup> November 2009** (23/11/2009)

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.
- (b) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for a Govt. servant in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt.
- (c) Relaxation of upper age limit for Departmental Candidates –
  - (i) Upper age limit will be relaxable upto the age of 35 years in respect of persons who are working in posts which are in the same line or allied cadre and where a relationship could be established that a service rendered in the Department will be useful for efficient discharge of the duties in other categories of post in the same Department, provided the age concession will be admissible only where an employee has rendered not less than three years continuous service in the same Department.
  - (ii) Upper age limit will be relaxable upto 40 years in respect of Departmental SC/ST candidates and 38 years in respect of Departmental OBC candidates satisfying the above conditions.
- (d) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years in the following categories:-
  - (i) The children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. SC/ST/OBC relaxation as per Govt. instructions will be in addition. Children and dependent family member should produce a certificate to that effect from the Collector of the concerned District where the victim was killed.
  - (ii) In case of all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01<sup>st</sup> day of January 1980 to the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1989.
- (e) Ex-Servicemen being trained soldier, only written test, trade test and medical fitness test to ascertain medical category will be conducted. As per Govt. orders total relaxation in prescribed physical standard and Education is admissible. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent of military service plus 3 years is applicable. No PET is required to be qualified by an Ex-serviceman.

8. **MEDICAL STANDARD:**

(i) **Eye Sight:** The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of 2 eyes without correction i.e. without wearing of glasses.

(ii) The candidates must not have knock-knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

9. **SELECTION PROCESS:** The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and venue of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:

a) **CHECKING OF DOCUMENTS:** The candidate will be required to produce the original and attested photocopies of the documents related to his Educational Qualification, Date of Birth etc. as mentioned in para 13.

b) **PHYSICAL MEASUREMENT:** Candidates who are found eligible on checking of documents will be screened first for **Height, Chest and Weight measurements** as per Para 7.

c) **PHYSICAL EFFICIENCY TEST (Qualifying only):** The candidates who are found fit in above Physical Measurements will be required to pass Physical Efficiency Test consisting of following events:-

(i)	1 mile race to be completed in six and half minutes
(ii)	11 feet long jump (3 chances to be given)
(iii)	3.5 feet high jump ( 3 chances to be given)

**Note:**

(i) Those who do not qualify the Physical Efficiency Tests will be discarded from that stage only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

(ii) No Physical Efficiency tests will be held for Departmental Candidates and Ex-Servicemen. However, Ex-Servicemen will be required to pass the requisite written, Trade test and medical examination.

d) **SCHEME OF EXAMINATION**:- The exam will consist of bilingual written test (objective/narrative questions), practical trade test and interview. Only those candidates who obtain the minimum qualifying standard in written test will be eligible for further tests. The detail of syllabus duration & passing marks for respective posts are given as under:-

e) **WRITTEN TEST**: Written Test which will consist of objective as well as narrative type questions. The papers can be answered either in Hindi or in English.

f) **TECHNICAL/TRADE TEST**:- The trade test for posts as mentioned above shall be conducted after the written test.

- g) **INTERVIEW**: Interview will be conducted for general disposition and soldierly traits assessment with a view to determining their suitability in an armed force.
- h) **DETAILED MEDICAL EXAMINATION**: Candidates selected in order of merit i.e. equal to the number of notified vacancies, will be put through a detailed medical examination to assess their fitness. Any physical defect, deformity like flat foot, knock-knee etc. will lead to be disqualification.
