RECRUITMENT FOR THE POST OF CONSTABLE (GENERAL DUTY)

Applications are invited from male Indian citizens, resident of the following States for filling up of vacancies for the year 2010 on temporary basis likely to be permanent, shown against each State for the post of **Constable (General Duty) Group ‘C’** in the Indo Tibetan Border Police Force. The post has all India liability and selected candidates can be posted anywhere in India and even abroad. On appointment, the candidate shall be governed by the ITBPF Act and Rules. The last date of receipt of application is 22-09-2010 (22nd September 2010) for all States except for Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Nagaland, Tripura, Sikkim, Ladakh Division of Jammu and Kashmir State, Lahaul-Spiti District and Pangi Sub-Division of Chamba District of HP, for which last date is 29-09-2010 (29th September-2010)

2. PAY SCALE AND OTHER ALLOWANCES: -

- Pay Scale - Rs. 5200 – 20200 + Grade Pay Rs. 2,000/- per month.
- Other allowances: The post will carry Dearness Allowance, Ration Money, Washing Allowance as admissible from time to time, Special Compensatory Allowance while posted in specified border areas, free uniform, free accommodation or HRA, Transport Allowance, Free leave pass and any other allowance as admissible in the Force from time to time under the rules/instructions. They will be covered under new restructured defined contributory pension scheme.

3. A candidate appearing for the test should mention/intimate if any criminal case(s) is/are pending/lodged against him in any police station/Hon’ble court.

5. ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

- (i) **AGE:** – Between 18 to 23 Years (Cut off date for determining the age will be 01 August 2010).

Note:-

- (a) Upper age limit is relaxable for SC/ST by 5 years and for OBC by 3 years.
- (b) Ex-Servicemen being trained soldier, only written test and Medical fitness test to ascertain Medical category will be conducted. Relaxation of upper age limit to the extent of military service plus 3 years is applicable. No PET is required to be qualified by an Ex-serviceman.
- (c) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to the children and dependent family members of those killed in 1984 riots and riots of 2002 in Gujarat. The SC/ST/OBC relaxation as per Govt. instructions will be in addition. Children and dependent family member should produce a certificate to that effect from the Collector of the concerned District where the victim was killed.
- (d) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years to all persons who had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu & Kashmir during the period from 01st day of January 1980 to 31st day of December 1989.

(e) Upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for Govt, Servant in accordance with the instructions issued by the Central Govt. Persons serving in Govt./Semi govt. department may send their applications through proper channel "No Objection Certificate" must be submitted at the time of recruitment.

(ii) **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:** –

a) **Matriculation or 10th Class** pass from a recognized Board/ University/National Open School (National Institute of Open School).

(iv) **Medical Standards:-**

- Eye Sight:** The minimum distant vision should be 6/6 and 6/9 of 2 eyes without correction i.e. without wearing of glasses.
- The candidates must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes and they should possess high colour vision. They must be in good mental and bodily health and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with the efficient performance of the duties.

6. **HOW TO APPLY AND BY WHICH DATE:-**

7. **APPLICATION FORM, FEE AND ITS COST:**

a) As per amended scheme of recruitment, the application form has been designed on OMR format and will be available w.e.f. 23-08-2010 onwards to the candidates at Head Post Office in each district for which vacancies have been notified in para 4 of this advertisement. The candidates may purchase application form from Post Office on payment of Rs. 40/- (Rupees forty only) (This amount is tentative and may increase depending upon the approval of competent authority in the Dept. of Post.)

It may be noted that photocopy/ Scanned copy of such application form will not be accepted.

b) **Application Fee:** The candidates belonging to General and OBC category will be required to pay Rs. 50/- (Non refundable) as application fee in form of IPO/Bank Draft in the name of "**ACCOUNTS OFFICER, DIRECTORATE GENERAL, ITB POLICE, NEW DELHI**" and no fee will be charged from SC/ST and Ex-Servicemen. The candidates should enclose the Indian Postal Order or Bank Draft with U clip and must not staple or attach with pin etc.

8. **ENCLOSURES REQUIRED TO BE ATTACHED WITH APPLICATION :-**

Only following may be attached with the application form.

(a) IPO/Bank Draft of Rs.50/- (for General and OBC Candidates only). Candidate must note that IPO/Bank Draft should not be stapled or attached with pin etc.

9. **DOCUMENTS/CERTIFICATE REQUIRED TO BE BROUGHT AT THE TIME OF RECRUITMENT TEST:-**

(a) Original certificate alongwith attested copies of following Certificates:-

(i) Educational Certificate.

(ii) Date of birth certificate (Matriculation or 10th Class certificate or certificate issued by National Open School /National Institute of Open School as proof of date of birth.)

(iii) Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/OBC Certificate (if belonging to any of these categories) issued by an authority not lower than Tehsildar or SDM. Note:- OBC certificate must be in prescribed proforma as attached at annexure -'I & II'.

(iv) Domicile Certificate issued by local revenue authorities for verification of citizenship / for claiming relaxation in height and chest.

(v) Discharge certificate for Ex-Servicemen.

10. **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The eligible candidates shall be issued Admit cards to appear in recruitment test. The date and place of recruitment test will be indicated in Admit card. Candidates will have to undergo the following tests:

a) Height Bar Test.

b) Those who qualify the height Bar test, will be subjected to 5 kilometers race to be completed within 24 minutes. In case of rectt. at Leh-Ladakh, candidates will be required to run 1.6 km. race to be completed within 6.30 minutes. **(Qualifying) (Those who do not qualify will be eliminated at this stage itself).**

c) Biometric identification

d) Testimonials of the candidates will be checked after the biometric identification process and only eligible candidates will go to the next steps.

e) **Physical Measurement:** Candidates who are found eligible on screening of testimonials will be screened first for height, chest and weight measurements.

- f) **Physical Efficiency Test (PET):** The PET will be qualifying in nature and will not carry any marks. The candidates who are found fit in Physical Measurements will be required to pass physical efficiency test consisting of following events:-

(i)	11 feet long jump (3 chances to be given)
(ii)	3 feet 6 inches high jump (3 chances to be given)

Note: Those who do not qualify the above Physical Efficiency Tests will get eliminated there only and will not be allowed to appear in further tests.

g) **Written Test (100 Marks):**

- (i) The candidates who qualify in the Physical Efficiency Test will be required to appear in a written test.
- (ii) The written test will consist of only **OMR based objective type multiple choice** questions to be answered using a pen.
- (iii) The question paper will be set (Bi-lingual i.e. in Hindi and English) to assess the general awareness/General Knowledge, Knowledge of Elementary Mathematics, analytical aptitude and ability to observe and distinguish patterns and to test basic knowledge of candidate in English/Hindi. The question paper will be multiple choice patterns and would carry 100 marks. The candidate will be required to answer in OMR answer sheet. The candidate will be allowed to take carbon copy of his OMR answer sheet. Answer key to the question paper will be posted on the website and displayed on the notice board after the written examination is completed.
- (iv) It is intimated that the OMR answer sheet of written test will be processed/scanned in electronic machine. Any wrong entry of i.e. roll number, name, Question booklet Number or question paper series will render the OMR sheet invalid and the same will not be evaluated. The concerned candidates will be responsible for such mistake on their part.
- (v) Minimum qualifying marks for General and Ex-Servicemen- 35% and for SC/ST and OBC category candidates is 33% .

h) **Interview:** There will be no interview in this recruitment.

i) **Merit Lists:** Merit lists in each category namely, Gen, SC, ST, OBC and ex-servicemen will be drawn separately in respect of each State/UT on the basis of marks obtained in the written test. On the basis of this merit list the candidates will be shortlisted for detailed medical examination.

j) **Medical Examination:**

Candidates short listed category wise in order of merit on the basis of written test will be medically examined to assess their physical & medical fitness.

11. All eligible candidates will be duly informed about the date and venue of the recruitment tests through admit card. Candidates should come duly prepared for 6-7 days stay under their own arrangements at the Recruitment Centre. The Government shall not be responsible for damage/injury, if any, to the individual sustained during the Physical Efficiency Test. **No TA/DA will be admissible. Incomplete application will be summarily rejected and no correspondence on this will be entertained. No application after the last date as mentioned above will be accepted.**

12. **Appeal against medical examination:**

- i. A candidate declared unfit for appointment in ITBPF in Detailed Medical Examination, the grounds for rejection will be communicated to him in broad terms by the Presiding Officer.
- ii. The candidate, if not satisfied with the findings of the Medical Officer, can submit an appeal application for his re-medical examination with a duly filled Medical certificate as per Form No. 6 at Annexure-IV as a place of evidence about the error judgment in the part of Rectt. Medical Officer.
- iii. The medical certificate will not be taken into consideration unless it contains a note by the medical practitioner concerned to the effect that it has been given in full knowledge of the fact that the candidate has already been rejected as unfit for appointment by a Medical Officer.
- iv. The appeal will also not be taken into consideration unless it contains Medical Re-Examination Fee of Rs. 25/- through Indian Postal Order or Demand Draft in the name of **Commandant, Base Hospital, ITB Police, New Delhi** and Rejection Slip (in original) issued by the Presiding Officer. The appeal should be submitted within 15 days from the date of issue of the communication i.e. Rejection Slip (ITBP will not be responsible for any postal delay) in which the findings of the Medical Officer are communicated to the candidate.
- v. The authority and address for sending the application for re-medical examination shall be intimated by the P.O. Rectt. Board while issuing the rejection slip.
- vi. The decision of the review medical board of ITBP shall be final and no 2nd appeal will be entertained as per Govt. instructions and also no reply of the correspondence/2nd appeal will be given/entertained.
