G.S.R. _____(E).— In exercise of the powers conferred by clause(b) of sub section(2) of section 156 of the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Act, 1992 (35 of 1992), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules to amend the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force Deputy Commandant (Armourer) and Assistant Commandant (Armourer), Group 'A' posts Recruitment Rules, 2019 namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.— (I) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Armourer Cadre (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2021.

(II) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Schedule to the Indo-Tibetan Border Police Force, Armourer Cadre (Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2019, -

(a) Against Rule no 9, relating to the age of superannuation, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

(1) Officers holding the ranks of Deputy Commandant (Armourer) and Assistant Commandant (Armourer) shall retire from service in the afternoon of the last day of the month in which they attain the age of sixty years:

Provided that the person whose date of birth is the first day of a month shall retire from service on the afternoon of the last day of the preceding month on attaining the age of sixty years, as the case may be.

(2) No personal shall be granted extension in service beyond the prescribed age of retirement or superannuation.

(b) Against serial number 1, relating to the post of Deputy Commandant (Armourer)-

(i) In column 2, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"4* (2021)

* Subject to variation dependent on workload."

(c) Against serial number 2, relating to the post of Assistant Commandant (Armourer)-

In column 2, for the entries, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"7* (2021)

* Subject to variation dependent on work load."
